The CIAA does not guarantee specific rows or seats within any given section. If the desired price level is not available at the time of assignment, the patron (Holder) will be placed in the next available lower price level. Persons with disabilities should send a copy of the ADA documentation. Persons with ADA documentation have priority assignment for handicap seats. A doctor's notice may suffice for ADA documentation. All other inquiries for ADA seating will be reviewed on a case by case basis. The CIAA will not refund customer payment for cancellation of request, by the Holder or Holder's designee. The Holder is the person whose name appears on the request. The designee is the person acting on behalf of the Holder. WARNING: BALLS AND OTHER OBJECTS MAY FLY INTO THE SPECTATOR AREAS AND CAUSE INJURY. STAY ALERT AT ALL TIMES, INCLUDING WARMUPS AND AFTER ANY STOPPAGE OF PLAY. NOTICE: HOLDER VOLUNTARILY ASSUMES ALL RISK OF PERSONAL INJURY AND DANGER (INCLUDING DEATH), PROPERTY LOSS OR DAMAGE ARISING FROM OR RELATED IN ANY WAY TO, THE EVENT, whether occurring prior to, during or after the Event, howsoever caused, and whether by negligence or otherwise. Holder further voluntarily agrees that the CIAA, its affiliates, the Event promoter and participants, and any of their respective owners, members, officers, directors, employees, sponsors, contractors, and other agents shall be expressly released by Holder from any claims arising from such causes. The CIAA reserves the right, without refund, to refuse admission to, eject from the arena, or bar from future events, any person whose conduct is deemed by the CIAA to be disorderly or who fails to comply with the terms and conditions contained herein and/or as posted. Unauthorized food or beverages or any contraband may be confiscated by the CIAA at any time. Tickets obtained from sources other than the CIAA or its authorized outlets maybe lost, stolen or counterfeit and will not be honored.
