Date/Time: Wednesday, February 28, 2018, from 9:30 – 1:30 p.m. Recruiters/vendors may arrive between 9:00 and 10:00 a.m. for set-up.

College Recruiters: CIAA Schools from Pennsylvania, Maryland, North Carolina and Virginia.

Attendees: More than 4,000 high school students and chaperones.

Program: An opening session will preview the various opportunities available to attendees. Participants then will rotate between and among the recruiting fair and various vendors.

Parking: There will be designated parking for buses on Martin Luther King Blvd. For all others, parking fees are for a minimal charge in surrounding parking garages including the NASCAR Hall of Fame parking lot, located at 500 South Brevard Street. Parking lots will fill quickly due to the work week and Education Day participants, so arrive early!
